What is the consultation title?*

Care and Support at Home Commissioning Strategy 2015-18

What is this consultation about?*

Some people have physical or mental health problems which makes it difficult for them to manage at home on their own. Northamptonshire County Council pays a range of organisations to employ home carers to help people that are eligible for this service, to remain at home and live as independently as possible.

Home carers assist with an individual's personal care, meals and keeping people safe in their own home. The care provided is based on a plan which states the care needs of the individual. This plan focuses on the tasks to do and the time when they have to be done by the home carers.

Over the next two years, our intention is to work with care providers to do things differently. We want to start with the customer as an individual who has strengths, preferences and aspirations. We want to allow them to make more choices about how they are supported to live their life.

To help us do this we will be looking more widely at how the customer's care needs can be met rather than just relying on paid 'hands on carers'.

We are developing a Care and Support at Home Commissioning Strategy 2015-18. This will outline how we will change and deliver this service over the next 3 years. We want to hear your views about the priorities of this service and how your local community can support people to live independently at home.
