What is this consultation about?*

Consultation on the Future of the Drayton Centre, Kingsthorpe and Stephenson Court, Kilsby Day Services Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) and Olympus Care Services (OCS), will be in a period of consultation with day centre users, relatives and other interested parties with a view to the possibility of closing both the Drayton Centre, Kingsthorpe, Northampton and Stephenson Court in Kilsby day services, and offering service users alternative provision if necessary.

The reason for this is that the County Council purchases some services on a 'block' basis. That is, a fixed number of places is purchased from people who provide services at an advantageous price and this also guarantees sufficient places. However, there are a considerable number of empty places across the day services for older people and this represents a waste of resources at a time when, as with many other councils; financial resources are very limited. We therefore believe that need can still be met even with the closure of the above two under-used day services.

Northamptonshire County Council recognises the value and importance of these services to service users and their family members/carers and difficult decisions need to be made due to the reduced funding from central Government and the rising demand for our services. Under these circumstances we have no alternative than to consider their closure. It is anticipated that closing these two under-used day services will save approximately £400,000 per annum for the County Council.

We are committed to involving users of the service, and family members/carers in decisions about the care they receive.

In addition to, and at the same time as the consultation we will be undertaking a review of individuals who use the service and their carers to ensure that people's needs can be met by alternative means.
