What is the consultation title?\*

Northamptonshire Early Years Single Funding Formula Consultation 2017/18

What is this consultation about?\*

Central Government are currently developing a new National Early Years Single Funding Formula (EYSFF). The proposals outlined will mean significant changes to the current Early Years Funding arrangements in Northamptonshire.

The purpose of this consultation is to seek your opinions on the components of a revised early years funding formula for three and four year olds, and the timeline of the implementation of the formula, both within the parameters of the national policy. Proposals may change in line with national proposals once final scheme arrangements are announced.

Responses to this consultation will be reviewed by NCC officers in December and the Schools Forum in January, before a further round of consultation in January and February. A final decision will be made in March 2017. Changes resulting from this consultation will be implemented from April 2017 onwards.

The outcomes of this consultation will affect the way your school/establishment is funded from April 2017.
