Consultation on Northamptonshire County Council's Prioritisation Framework and Process

In total, 123 responses were received during the consultation period. Of the 39 respondents who answered questions about the proposed ethical framework, 63% (24 consultees) either 'agreed' or 'strongly agreed' with the values and principles stated therein; 25% (10 consultees) 'neither agreed nor disagreed' with the values and principles, and 10% (4 consultees) disagreed.

There were 28 responses to the question about the proposed prioritisation criteria. Of these, 17 were in agreement with the proposed criteria (11% 'strongly agree' and 50% 'agree'), while 3 people (11%) 'disagreed' and 7 people (25%) 'neither agreed nor disagreed'.

An important part of this consultation involved seeking people's opinions on whether or not the prioritisation tool would work and, as such, we asked if the questions asked as part of the prioritisation tool were the right ones to assess if the criteria were being met. In total, there were 27 responses to this question, of which 12 people 'neither agreed nor disagreed' with the questions asked (44%); 10 'agreed' or 'strongly agreed' (37%) and 4 'disagreed' or 'strongly disagreed' (15%).

Because the consultation was online only, and conducted over a relatively short period of time, fewer responses were received than expected. As this is an important area for consultation, additional public consultation on the Prioritisation Framework and Process will be carried out in the New Year, clarifying the content of the consultation and inviting further views and opinions.
