

NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

PROPOSAL TO INCREASE THE PERMANENT CAPACITY OF ALL SAINTS CHURCH OF ENGLAND (VA) PRIMARY SCHOOL FROM 210 TO 420 PLACES

In accordance with the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, a proposal is being published by Northamptonshire County Council, County Hall, Northampton, NN1 1DN regarding the provision of primary education in Wellingborough.

The proposal is that: as there is no room for expansion on the current site of All Saints Church of England (VA) Primary School, Castle Street, a second site on Croyland Road, would be established and operate as an annex. It is also proposed that the capacity of All Saints Church of England (VA) Primary School increase from a one form entry (total 210 pupils) school to a two form entry school (420 pupils). The school's published admission number (PAN) will permanently increase from 30 to 60 pupils per year group, although this will be introduced in a phased way, according to demand for places.

This proposal has been made in response to the increase in demand for pupil places which is due to a rising birth rate, new housing developments and in-migration into Wellingborough town.
