

Planning Statement:

Process:

Bring securely car from local auction. No traffic should be generated by this operation.

Place it in side of the unit - empty all liquids to a designated tank. Drain all liquids to special containers. Those containers will take away by recycle waste management company.

All operations will be taken in the unit, like taking parts e.g. engine on the pallet stored in side of the building.

In the end of the process the shell will be securely send to the local scrap yard. - no additional traffic should be created.

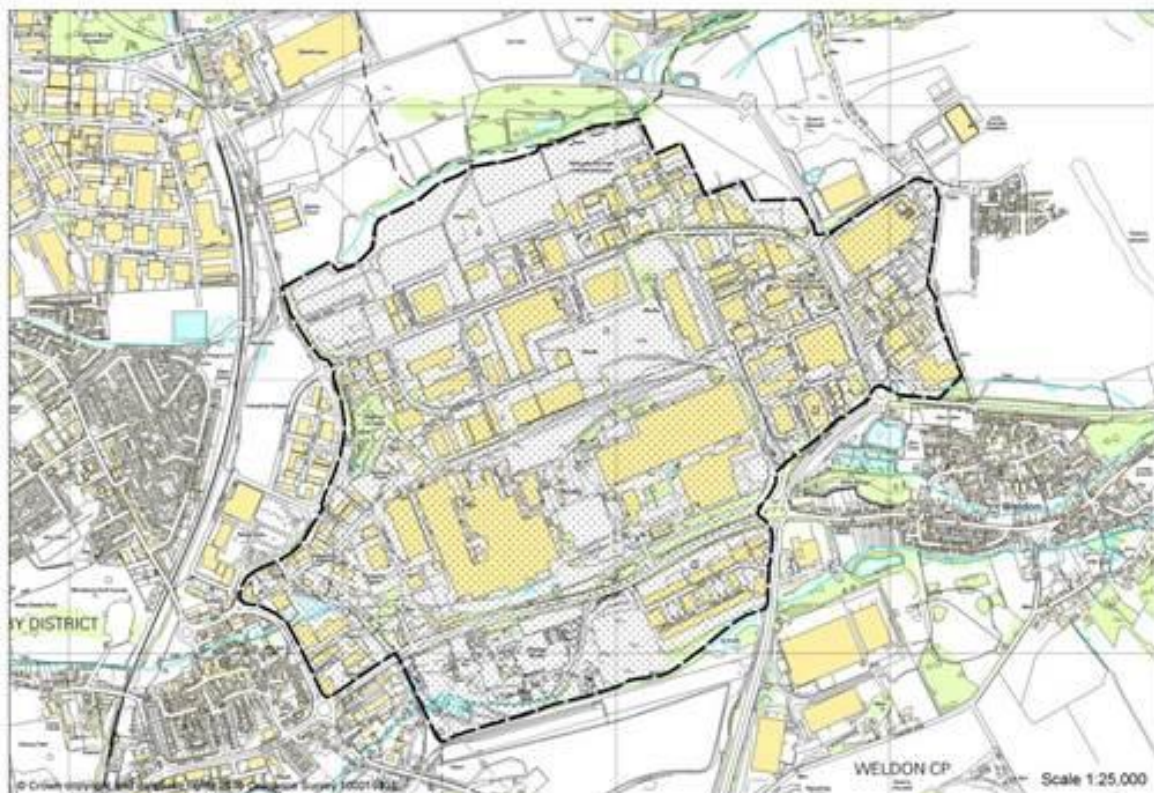
The parts will be stored on site and loaded to the van or lorry - no additional traffic.

The proposal is for small scale e.g. cars for special, personal orders.

- Policy 10, 12 and 18- The proposal is for a waste development. The outside space won't be used for this proposal. We would like to change of use to a waste management facility processing end of life vehicles, segregating parts and materials and sorting other material for scrap. All tasks will be completed inside the garage part.
- We would be stripping cars and segregate vehicle parts (metal and plastic) and all car liquids (e.g. brake fluid, oil, cooling system water) to designated waste containers and then we would be collaborating with local scrap yards and local recycling centre.
