**NORTH-WEST RELIEF ROAD: REQUEST FOR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (EIA)
SCOPING OPINION**

Following our phone call on the 02 August 2018, please accept this letter and enclosed Scoping Report as a request for a Scoping Opinion on the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the proposed North-West Relief Road (NWRR). The Scoping Report is submitted under Regulation 15 of the Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations (England) 2017. The purpose of the EIA Scoping Report is to inform Northampton County Council, statutory consultees, and key stakeholders about the proposed scope of the EIA, the findings of which will be presented in the ES that will accompany any subsequent planning application for the proposed NWRR.

The proposed NWRR will be located on land approximately 1.2km south-east of Church Brampton and immediately east of the Brampton Heath Golf Centre. The proposed NWRR will connect the A5199 Welford Road, via Sandy Lane, with a proposed junction located adjacent to Grange Farm, which will provide access to the future Dallington Grange Kings Heath residential development.
