



## MOTOR HOMES

- Motor homes are permitted to park in a residents' parking bay provided that they park displaying a valid permit and that they comply with the requirements of the vehicle type and size as detailed on the Resident's Parking Permit page.
- If the vehicle is registered to the resident then the process detailed on the Resident's Parking Permit page should be followed.
- If the vehicle is hired by the resident then the rules detailed on the Hire Cars page applies.
- Residents should not assume that they can use their Visitors Parking Permit in such circumstances as this is deemed misuse of the scheme and if observed, a Penalty Charge Notice would be issued. Written permission is required from Northamptonshire County Council to allow use of the Visitors Parking Permit
- Permits must be displayed in the vehicle ensuring all the written details on the permit are **clearly visible** through the windscreen at all times. **Failure to comply may result in a Penalty Charge Notice being issued.**
- Permit holders are reminded to check the signage prior to leaving their vehicle, in particular limited waiting bays.
