THE NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BYWAY TE10 -
PARISH OF ECTON)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER, 1991

The Northamptonshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 1(2) and 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (Byway TE10 - Parish of Ecton) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1991" and shall come into force on the 28th October 1991.
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or of a traffic warden in uniform, cause any motor vehicle or horse drawn vehicle to proceed in that length of Byway TE10 in the Parish of Ecton from its junction with Lower Ecton Lane for a distance of approximately 100 metres in an easterly direction.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle or horse drawn vehicle to proceed in the length of byway referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used:
 - (a) to gain access to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of byway;
 - (b) for the purpose of agriculture on any land adjacent to that length of byway or for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
 - (c) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to that length of byway of any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the byway; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to, the byway, of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications equipment as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984;
 - (d) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (e) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a pedal-cycle to proceed in the length of byway referred to in that Article.
