(PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northamptonshire County Council have made an Order under Sections 1 to 5 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The general effect of the Order is to prohibit any motor vehicle or horse drawn vehicle (except two wheeled motor vehicles, motorcycle combinations or horse drawn vehicles the width of which does not exceed 5ft - 6") from proceeding along those lengths of Byways as specified in the Schedule below.

A **COPY** of the Order may be inspected at Northamptonshire Highways, One Angel Square, Angel Street, Northampton, NN1 1ED during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will become effective on the 30th March 2018.

SCHEDULE

- 1. Byways TC12 & TE11 beginning off Unclassified Highway leading to bridleway at NGR SP 8475 6252, travelling west for approximately 1857 metres to NGR SP 8295 6230 at the junction with TE10.**
- 2. Unclassified Highway beginning off Grendon Road at NGR SP 8488 6247, travelling west to a point 36 metres south of the southern highway boundary of the A45 Northampton to Wellingborough road at NGR SP 8475 6249.**
