**(PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2015**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Northamptonshire County Council have made an Order under Sections 1 to 5 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit pedestrians from using Public Footpath UL10 (part) in the Borough of Wellingborough and Public Footpath TL5 (part) in the Parish of Irchester as specified in the schedule below.

A **COPY** of the Order, together with a plan showing the exact lengths of road to which it relates may be inspected at Irchester Library, High Street, Irchester, or at the offices of The Traffic Order Section, Riverside House, Bedford Road, Northampton, NN1 5NX during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

This Order will become effective on the 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2015.

**SCHEDULE**

Public Footpath UL10 beginning at National Grid Reference ('NGR') SP 9183 6703 at the junction with Public Footpath UL9, travels in a south-south easterly direction for approximately 20 metres to the parish boundary where it becomes Public Footpath TL5, continues for a further 97 metres to NGR SP 9188 6694.
