THE NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BYWAY AZ55 - PARISH OF SYRESHAM)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER, 1990

The Northamptonshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 1(2) and 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (Byway AZ55 - Parish of Syresham) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1990" and shall come into force on the 22nd January, 1990.
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or of a traffic warden in uniform, cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of byway specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of byway referred to in that Article if the motor vehicle is being used:
 - (a) to gain access to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of byway;
 - (b) for the purpose of agriculture on any land adjacent to that length of byway or for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
 - (c) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to that length of byway of any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the byway; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to, the byway, of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications equipment as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984;
 - (d) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (e) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a motorcycle or a pedal-cycle to proceed in the length of byway referred to in that Article.

(Length of Byway)

Byway AZ55

Byway AZ55 in the Parish of Syresham running from its junction with the Towcester to Brackley Trunk Road (A43) at Grid Reference SP 651 423 running in a generally north-westerly direction to its junction with the Syresham to Wappenham Road at Grid Reference SP 632 433, a distance of approximately 2,240 metres.
