ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BYWAY SC40 PARISH OF WAPPENHAM)  
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1998

The Northamptonshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and 2(2) - (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (Byway SC40 - Parish of Wappenham) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1998" and shall come into force on the 12th day of October 1998.
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or of a traffic warden in uniform, cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of byway specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of byway referred to in that Article if the motor vehicle is being used:
  - (a) to gain access to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of byway;
  - (b) for the purpose of agriculture on any land adjacent to any of those lengths of byway or for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
  - (c) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to any of those lengths of byway of any of the following operations, namely;
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the byway; or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to, the byway, of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications equipment as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (d) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (e) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a motorcycle or a pedal-cycle to proceed in any of the lengths of byway referred to in that Article.

SCHEDULE

**(Lengths of Byway)**

That length of Byway SC40 in the parish of Wappenham from its junction with the unclassified road leading to Wappenham Lodge Farm at Grid Reference SP632441 running in a generally northeasterly direction to its junction with Byway SC14 at Grid Reference SP638446

That length of Byway SC40 in the parish of Wappenham from its junction with the Wappenham to Syresham road (Class III) at Grid Reference SP631452 running in a generally southeasterly direction to its junction with Byway SC14 at Grid Reference SP638446.
